

Mayor Moses Maluleke delivering a keynote address during the official launch of the Nkuna City, a smart city project with an estimated value of R1.5 billion at Nkuzana village in Collins Chabane Municipality.

The project is expected to create 8000 jobs during construction and 6000 permanent jobs being created during its full operation.

Nkuna City is the latest brainchild of Dr Mike Nkuna which is in direct response to the pronouncement made at the 2020 State of the National Address by Honourable President Ramaphosa to develop post-apartheid Smart Cities and Towns.

The Mayor has emphasized the commitment made by the Municipality to create 12 townships in Collins Chabane, inviting investors as part of fighting unemployment as well as developing areas along R81 roads as part of creating job opportunities.
