"On behalf of the people of Collins Chabane Local Municipality, the provincial government and other parts of the society, we want to send our heartfelt condolences to the family of Mrs Moyana. We appreciate the invaluable contribution you have made to the community of Collins Chabane and all our road users. There is nothing as devastating as the death of a loved one, a dedicated soldier, but what is more painful, is the pain of facing this devastation alone, without your closest family members, friends and relatives and our presence here is a reflection that we all loved your daughter, this our attempt to sooth your pain", said Mayor Maluleke.

"This dignified send-off is another way of communicating our love, honor and respect to Mrs Moyana that she was a valuable asset to the Municipality and the people of Collins Chabane and we will always remember her and protect the legacy she left in our books and memories, may her soul Rest In Peace", said the Mayor.

Bishop B.R Malumani of Worship Tabernacle Christian Centre closed the funeral with a sermon that brought healing to mourners.
