

Mayor leads R81 roadblock

The Mayor of Collins Chabane, Cllr Moses Maluleke participated in stop and search operation by the provincial and local traffic officers together with the police on the R81 road between Saselamani and Mhinga.

Maluleke was backed up by the Road Traffic Inspectorate, Collins Chabane Local Municipality traffic officers, Customs and the SA Police Services at the roadblock.
